

Regional Tsunami Evacuation Map



When a major earthquake occurs and Tsunami warning issues




How to use the tsunami evacuation map

- 1 Check the location of your home or hotel.**
 - Safer place such as high ground or an evacuation building.
- 2 Stay Calm. Do not panic. Be prepared for strong tremors.**
 - Watch out for falling furniture and falling objects.
- 3 Evacuate immediately from coastal regions and riverside areas to a safer place such as high ground or an evacuation building.**
 - Check the situation on devices such as your mobile phone, television, and radio.
 - Those in apartment complexes and apartment houses must evacuate to upper floors (3rd floor or higher).



Let's discuss your evacuation place with family

Safer place or Shelter that be used for temporary evacuation (Emergency response type)



Facilities that can be used for prolonged evacuation (Long term response type)



Tsunami warnings and advisories

If you feel a strong tremor there is a possibility of a tsunami. Take immediate action for evacuation!
